West Haddon Endowed Church of England Primary School. 1825 – 2025 (200 years of History)

This week, the children and staff of West Haddon Endowed Church of England Primary School have been celebrating its 200-year Anniversary. We have dressed up in Georgian/Victorian school costumes. Teachers held a 'Georgian/Victorian day of lessons' in their classrooms to give children an idea of what it would have been like to be at school in 1825 and how much education has changed over the years! Wendy Raybould a member of West Haddon History Society, came into school to talk to our Key Stage 2 children about both the school and village history. The school was founded in 1825 by an endowment from John Heygate. The school, a Church of England primary and nursery, serves children aged 2-11 and ensures Christian values are central to the school's ethos and educational approach.
