<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be looking at fractions including comparing and ordering fractions, fractions as numbers and equivalent fractions. We will be learning about length, perimeter and mass. We will also be consolidating our written addition, subtraction, multiplication and division methods.

Please remember to keep helping your child to practise their times tables regularly including asking questions in and out of order on the 2,3,4,5, 8 and 10 times tables and the associated division facts and larger number facts e.g. I know that $3 \times 4 = 12$, so $3 \times 40 = 120$. The children are now using their times table facts daily in math's lessons and are working towards knowing all of their times tables ready for the Year 4 multiplication check.
