# **Topic**

In Geography, we will be starting our new unit of work all about the UK. Our first few lessons will delve into the countries that make up the UK and their capital cities. Later in the Summer Term, we will also map out the village and enhance our field work skills.

#### Maths

This term, the children will be focussing on money, time and shape. We will be looking at areas such as: converting between pounds and pence, telling the time to the nearest minute and completing a symmetric figure. We will also link our homework to what we are learning in school.

The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) test is looming closer and will be carried out on the first week of June! We would appreciate it if you could support your child with learning their multiplication tables at home on a regular basis in order to help their pace of recall and accuracy. Practising online using a touchscreen in the same format as the test will be invaluable. Please ask your child to focus particularly on the questions they are finding tricky. ## **English**

In English this term, we will be spending some time exploring non-chronological reports, learning how to organise and present factual information clearly. Then, we will focus on reading and writing poetry in a range of forms. Finally, we will be developing our skills in letter writing, thinking carefully about audience, purpose and tone. The children will also be focussing on writing sentences using fronted adverbials, embedded clauses and speech punctuation to develop their creative writing.

#### Homework

Children will continue to be set Maths and SPAG homework in their CGP books each week on Thursdays. This is due in the following Tuesday. Please ensure that your child is reading at home at least twice per week. If your child chooses to read independently, please still ensure that this is signed. Regular spelling practice will also ensure that children score well on their weekly tests each Tuesday. Please recap previous spellings from time to time to help your child retain them in their long-term memory.

Our new class book, **The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S. Lewis**, will also be given out this term.
Please ensure your child is also regularly reading this.
The children's previous class reader, The Firework
Maker's Daughter, should be returned on the first week back (23<sup>rd</sup>- 25<sup>th</sup> April). Our class books are numbered to check any that are missing.
