#### Welcome

## **English**

Writing genres this term are myths, recounts for different audiences and flashbacks.

It remains extremely important that your child is reading regularly at home. Please ensure that your child has the opportunity to read a range of texts both independently as well as with an adult to encourage confidence, progression and most importantly, a love of reading. As part of their homework in Year 5, children need to read at least twice a week with an adult at home. Please initial reading records, these will be collected each Wednesday. In addition, children will be set a reading comprehension task each week. This should be completed and handed in by Tuesday with their maths and SPaG homework.

#### Homework

Homework will be set on a Thursday and should be handed in by the following Tuesday. A weekly spelling test will take place on Thursday mornings. Times tables (now including division facts) will be tested on Wednesdays. Our class book this term is There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom by Louis Sacher.
