I am delighted to tell you that our school has had another successful year with our end of Key Stage data and the children have performed very well.

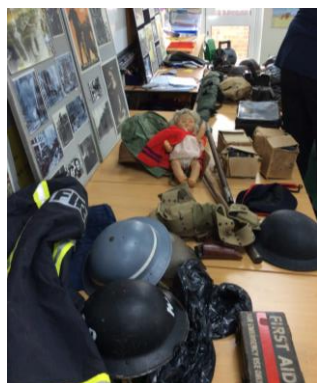
